Distemper in Dogs

Take a Nickle Box of Bluing & divide it into three parts, beat up well each part with an Egg
 Give three times a day; Morning, Evening & Night

Colic in Horses

$\frac{1}{2}$ Pint Roseum oil

$\frac{1}{2}$ Pint Sweet Milk

$\frac{1}{2}$ Pint of Sand or Molasses; Sand preferred

Stimery in Horses

Disolve salt in hot water as long as the ^{water} ^{tastes}
 it up. Then apply as hot as the horse can stand

Blind Staggers

Blind well in the neck

& give $\frac{1}{2}$ of Epsom salts, Dissolve in water & drink

For Coughs or Hoarses

Oil Tar - Give one Teaspoon full - pull out the
 Tongue & pour on the Tongue

Tonic Powder

$\frac{1}{2}$ Ounce of Camphor Gum (pulverized),

$\frac{1}{4}$ Ounce of Copraes (pulverized),

$\frac{1}{4}$ Ounce of Bealmond, Mix well all together

& give Teaspoon every Night for ten days.

Cholera in Chickens

- 1 Teaspoon full of Murriatic Acid (Dilute)
 4 Tablespoons full of Boiled Water (This
 to a gal of Water, Mix in Meal & feed

Cure for Roup in Chickens

Camphor Phenique
 Out on a feather and swab
 the throat out well.

For small chickens, dilute
 with water Repeat it once a
 day until cured.
