- Main Campus enrollment stands at 15,852 a decrease of 214 students from the Fall 2001 semester
- The 2,776 African American students enrolled represent 18% of the total main campus enrollment
- Admission of First-Time Freshmen decreased by 18 students, from 1,777 Fall 2001 to 1,759 Fall 2002
- Average ACT score for First-Time Freshmen is 23.8
- 1,759 New First-Time Freshmen, including 38 National Merit Scholars
