Surveying contract

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Contract with John E. Willis to run
the northern boundary line of Oklahoma
County due west beginning at the mouth of
Butterfly hatchy at the rate of two dollars
per mile to be paid of the first moneys of
that shall be collected for county purposes
said will is to mark the above line with
three chops on every tree with in three feet
of said line and put up mile post every mile
and mark two pointers at each mile post and
said will is to run a line north till it joins
the northern boundary line of said county
commencing at the dividing line between 13 and
14 running north this 31st March 1834

Ordered by the Board that E. Hogan
be authorized to employ Wm. E. Willis
surveyor to survey and mark the
Northern Boundary line of this County
Provided that said Hogan shall not give
said Willis more than 2¢ per mile and
provided that said Willis will make the
said survey and a return of the same to
this Board on or before the first day of May
1884.

The Board further ordered that the
above survey be made according to law
and a return of the same made under
oath to this Board by the time stated
above. Provided said Willis be employed
