#### SUMMARY

- Main Campus enrollment stands at 14,422, this number excludes those students who are enrolled exclusively on-line
- The 2,821 African American students enrolled represent 19.6% and the total minority enrollment is 3,177 or 22.0%. Both based on total main campus enrollment
- Enrollment of First-Time Freshmen decreased by 55 students, from 1,966 Fall 2005 to 1,911 Fall 2006
- Average ACT score for First-Time Freshmen is 23.3
- 24 National Merit Scholars students

- The highest graduate enrollment program is in Business Administration (BA) with 122 students, followed by Engineering (ENGR) with 120
- The enrollment in Veterinary Medicine (DVM) is 264
- Undeclared undergraduate enrollment (UND) is 1,079 while unclassified graduate enrollment (UNC) is 149
