that I Nicolas Fitzsimons am held  
& firmly Bound unto A Bill in the  
Penal Sum of Seventy hundred  
dollars The Payment well & Truly to  
be made and done I Bind myself my  
Heirs Etc firmly By These Presents  
Signed with my Seal and dated  
this the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February 1836

The Condition of the above obli-  
-gation is such that whereas the said  
Fitzsimons has this day Bargained  
& Sold unto A Bill a certain Tract  
of Land known as The poleus The  
South West quarter of Section 21 Town  
-Ship 19 R 15 East now if the said  
Fitzsimons make to A Bill Heirs & Heirs  
Etc an Oath to be made a good &  
Lawful Title to the aforesaid Land  
Then this obligation to be null & void  
otherwise to Remain in full force  
and effect This under my hand  
and Seal and date as above
