Mr. Wells. The weather is so bad I think it doubtful about my getting down to see you, I send a girl Gusty. She has a terrible disposition. I want you to cure her. do not treat her cruelly. but make her know her place.

I send a bolt of cloth for the negroes who have had no winter clothes - Please get Mr. Wells to divide it amongst them -

I send you two barrels molasces - the negroes must do on 2¹/₂ pint & a half molasces a week - it is about what other people do.

I shall probably leave tomorrow night
Thursday. 16th Jan 62.
