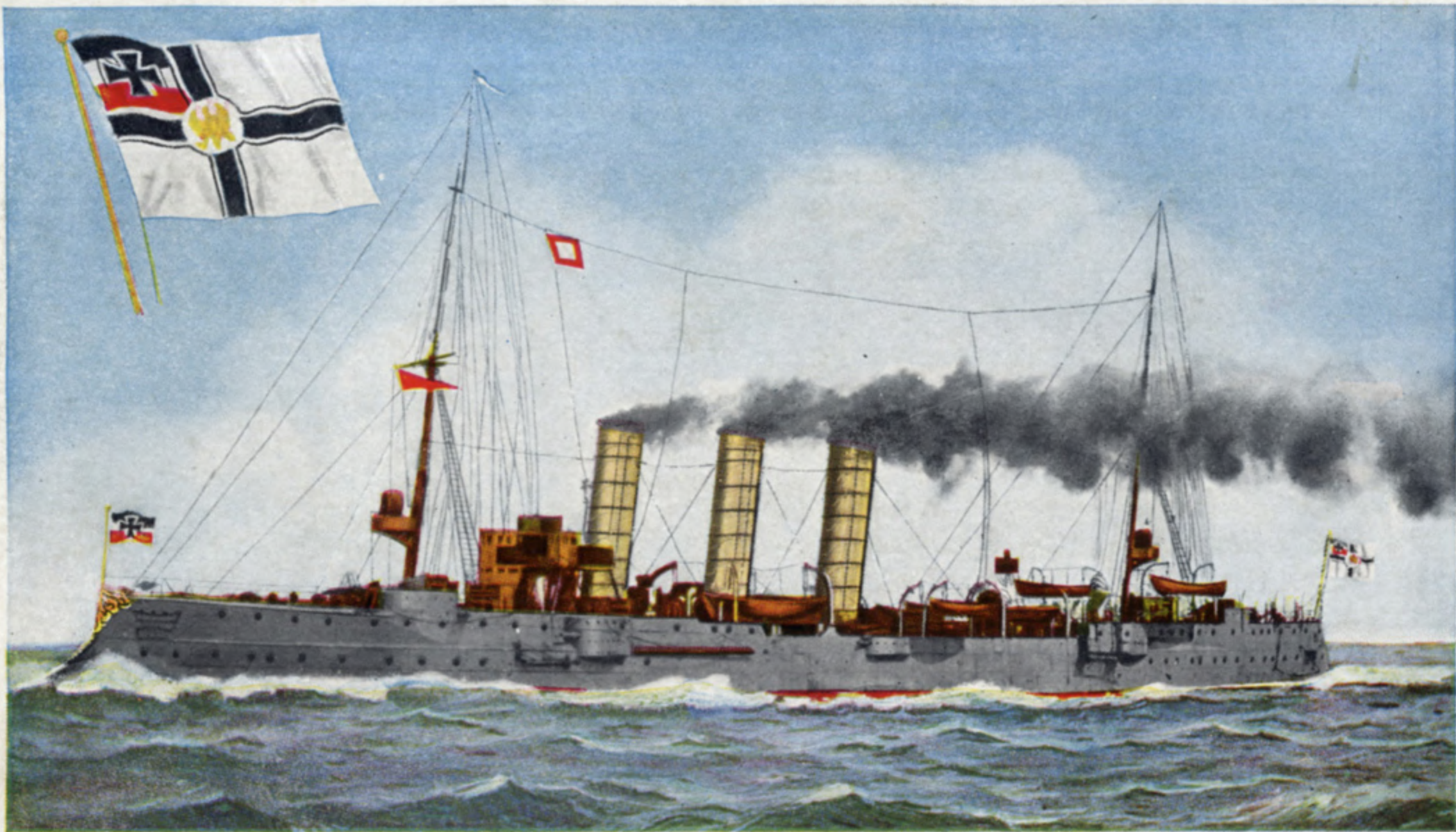

THE BREMEN, of the German Navy, is a third class cruiser. Displacement, 3,200 tons. Length, 341 feet. Width, 43 $\frac{1}{4}$ feet. Draft, 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet. Horse-power, 10,000. Armament: 10 4.1-inch guns; 10 1.4-inch; 4 machine and 2 light guns. Speed, 23 knots. Crew, 268 officers and men. Built at Bremen, Germany, in 1903-4. Cost about \$1,275,000.
