New Orleans 14 March 1835

Mr. Irons

Sir, please in receipt of your statement  
of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Inst, with your draft on us of \$1300 -  
which we have accepted with much pleasure, and we now  
bring you Subs of Five Balbs Old, which we hope  
will be found to you as satisfactory, like we also  
in receipt of Six Balbs more for your account, which  
we shall sell first upon all opportunity, and for our  
account Subs with you same as current - We  
accepted Thomas Crafton's draft of \$1950 - and of the  
Grounds here placed to your credit of \$1000 - and have  
sent below say \$726.32 to our mutual friend  
Thomas Craig Esq., should you lack Six Balbs sell  
for a pretty good price, there will still be a small  
balance in your favor, which we will try & get  
to you in some way - The demand is pretty  
fair at about 15 c 1/2 of average rates -  
extreme rates 13 c 1/2
