RECEIPT.

A L Palmer, of *Stonewall* County, and State
of *Miss* has this day, for the consideration of one dollar, transferred to us all the
right, title, claim and demand which *he* now has to recover and get back from the Government of the
United States, or any officer or agent thereof, any and all sums of money which the said

A L Palmer
has heretofore paid to the United States as a tax on Cotton, under and by virtue of the laws in such case made
and provided.

We hereby bind ourselves, by these presents, to refund the said *A L Palmer*
his heirs, or assigns, or legal representatives, one-half of whatever sums of money
may be collected (arising from the funds which the said party may have paid), upon the return of this
obligation, with the proper receipts endorsed thereon.
