Mobile July 22nd 1846

See as in some short time
after my arrival in this place your
boy Lewis was taken sick and died
I sent him to the City Hospital where
he was well attended to. I will give
you a copy of Dr Crawford's Certifi-
cate. (vis)

Mobile Feb. 14th 1846

This is to certify that the negro boy Lewis of
Mrs J. Robinson was brought to the City
Hospital on Feb. 3^d and died Feb. 5th
of Phrenitis signed W. B. Crawford M.D.
I have nothing of interest - to offer
you. This market is rather dull
for the sale of cotton seed or
any thing else.
