This Indenture made & entered into this fifteenth day of Samuary eighteen hundred & eight by & between William Caldwell of the city of Natchez in the Missisphi Territory of the first part & John Glassburn of the city Iterritory aforesaid of the second part WITA ESSETH Short the said party of the first for & in consideration that the said party of the second part hath become security for the said party of the first part to one Isaiah Packard in the sum of two hundred sixty two bollars & fefty cents by two notes of han each for the sum of one hundred othirty oudd: -lars twenty five courts said notes bearing date the twenty ninth day of becember one thousand eight hundred seven & being payable the one of them in the morot of May eighteen hundred & eight & the other being payable in one year from the date there of bfor the purpose of provinting the said party of the second part from nestaining any los or damage on account of his being recurity for the said party of the first part in manner of orm aformaid. Hath given granted bargained rold released conveyed bronfirmed and by these presents dork give grant bargain sell release convey occonfirm unto the said party of the second part bto his heirs & afrigues forever all that piece or Lot of Land rituated lying being in the city of Natcher of oresaid & at the landing place of the said large spring under the sluff it being on the North side thereof & being offsite the \$100086 occupied by Hennedy & the sens as a bake house & being i more on the Porth side thereof by a lot owned by Swepth Strickland together with all singular the rights privileges appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining & the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders rents if wes & profits thereof ball the estate interest claim or demand of the said party of the first part either in lawor equity to any part or parcel thereof with the appurtenences. To Have & TO Hold the above bargained & granted premises with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heis & apiques to his b their own only sole proper use benefit & behoof forwer -Provided Never Mells 8 these presents are upon this express condition that if the saidparty of the first part shall do well bruly pay the said notes of hand above mentioned for the payment whereof the said party of the second part is recurity for the said party of the first part or shall in any way discharge or satisfy the same b shall will brindy keep & save the said party of the second harmly from all lop or damage on account thereof or any thing concerning the same then by thereforth they purets being matters thing herein contained shall cease ditermine the utterly void & of no account anything herein contained to the Contray nowithstanding & the said party of the feest part for himself his him executors admin = = trators & afrigue both hereby covenant & agree to & with the said party of the sceond part his hour executors & administration that he the said party of the second part his him executors administrators & afrigues that I may at any time & at all times after befault shall have been made in the premises peaceably & quietly have hold use occupy possess berijoy the said lot of land therembeson described with
