This Indenture made on the 21st day of
February A.D. 1835, between General Bull-
-ock ^{and his wife} of the County of Holmes in the State
of Mississippi, and Aaron Spells of
the same County and State of the other
part witnesseth - That the said General
Bullock ^{by his wife} of the first part, for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred
and Twenty five dollars to the said General
in hand paid by the said Aaron Spells
before the entering and delivery of these
presents (The receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged) hath granted bargained
and sold, and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell and confirm
to the said Aaron Spells the following
tract or parcel of land lying being well
situate in the County and State aforesaid,
(viz) Being the East half of
the South West quarter of Section
Twenty Seven of Township fourteen
of Range Two East - To have and
to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel
of land, containing Eighty acres by
the same more or less, to the said Aaron
Spells and his heirs forever - And the said
General Bullock for himself his

was to the said parcel of land to the said
Aaron Spells his heirs &c with forever
Warrant & defend, against all claims
whatsoever. In testimony whereof
the said ^{parties} ~~Deed~~ Bullcock hath
hereunto set his hand and affixed
his seal on the day and year above
