**5-2-13. Bill of sale for three African American men in their twenties, Tom, Harrison, and Nathan, sold by professional slave traders, Reynolds Marshall & Co., who operated at the Forks of the Road slave market, to Samuel Davis, planter. Natchez, 1834. One 19.8cm x 11.6cm page.**

It reads: "Rec<sup>d</sup> of Sam<sup>l</sup> Davis Esq, Twenty four Hundred Dollars, being in full for the following Negroes warranted slaves for Life, viz Tom, Harrison & Nathan. Natchez, 18-Feb: 1834. [signed] Reynolds Marshall & Co." Au verso is the notation: "Reynolds Marshall & Co Bill of Sale of 3 negroes Tom 26 Harrison 24 Nathan 22 \$2400 18 Feb 1834." Professionally de-acidified and encapsulated between reversible archival mylar.
