 Hundred (\$84000) Dollars, as follows to-wit: Four
 Thousand Three Hundred dollars, in cash paid
 and two certain promissory notes of even date
 here with, One for Twenty one Hundred dollars
 due January 1st 1902, and the other for Two
 Thousand dollars due January 1st 1903, each
 of said notes bearing interest from date at eight
 per cent per annum until paid, and signed
 by the grantee herein, I hereby convey and
 warrant unto Mrs May A. Boswell the
 following described real estate lying and
 being in the County and state aforesaid, to-wit:

 also E³/₄ of NW¹/₄ Said Sec 17 T15 R18 - also

 T15 R18, east. I hereby expressly release
 a vendor's lien on all of the above lands
 until said two notes are fully paid -
