Dear Sis,

I have not heard from
You all for so long that I
feel very much worried
and almost want to send
a cable to enquire what
You are doing and how
You all are. Are you
not coming abroad?
We wanted You to get
here to visit us during

June - We will be here
quietly until the 1st of
July, when we shall
go for a trip somewhere
the best and longest
we can afford - of course
being still so untraveled
I must see all of Germany
and then we want to
go as far north as possi-
ble, but that all we
will plan before starting.
What I want to know is

When you are coming over
Can't you get here by the 1st of June
and spend all that month at
least, here? as you have not come
earlier - Do sit down immedi-
ately and write me your plans -

We want to hear so much, and
want to see you Mr. Palmer and
the boys. - Don't you just mention
also, if there is the least chance of
Ma's coming over or Aunt Laver
coming so - or do you think it at all
probable that Barry and his wife
are coming. I really can't keep
guessing injured when none of you
will answer my questions on these
points. I have just written to R., the

5th -
" I will no longer allow
him to decide when he
will come, but will ex-
pect him in the last of
this week or of the 2nd
of May. Our spec-Box
will be no longer ours,
after June and as we rely
on it through his kindness
I want him to come
while we have it - I have
been ^{allowing} ~~sentencing~~ it to be
used by travelling Missionaries

during the last month,
so much to my regret,
have not gone often in-
sleeper, but it is a very nice
compliment to say
these visitors - Another
year I must come
over earlier, and we
must try to take that
trip which I have had
much talked of, to London
Triple, Athens etc. -
I am the same old poke

find it always hard to get away -
but think this year it is just time
for us to stay until July when the
children can leave and travel, ^{here}
so much to amuse ourselves as
for general information and to see
the little places of historical interest
We are so anxious to see you all,
and hear from you when you will
be here, and all your plans -
do please write. I know you have
much on hand and are very busy,
but we are so anxious to hear - We
also have been intensely occupied and
much so, my time is all taken up
with nothing - We have done a great
deal of going out and all the enter-
taining we could - Please write soon

would write as soon as
you can after receiving
this - I am perfectly un-
founded at the idea of
Ma's having bought a
house and cannot be-

it true that Aunt Anna
has sold out and was
she a good profit or
not? How are you
not coming over when we
want to see you so much
the first of June? Do
let us hear - Where will
you travel during the
summer, what would your
plans be? We are still
