Dear Cammie:-

I received your letter of 31st. ultimo advising that you would be in Jackson with the boys on the following Thursday and requesting that I meet you all there. I am sorry that the date conflicted with that of my engagement to attend Justice Court in Jones County - matters pertaining to The Peoples Bank of Summerland, which I am winding up. I would have liked very much to have seen you all before the boys got off, however I am sure that you have impressed ~~with~~ them with the correct ideas and instructed them as they should do &c. I think you have ~~not~~ sent them to a good school. I enclose you my check for \$50.00 that I hope will apply to some extent on the expenses of Mims. You may advise me later when more is needed. I hope you all keep well.

This reminds me - Mama writes me that you have been sick again. I want to insist Cammie that you look more to your health. You just must take better care of yourself and consult good physicians and follow their instructions and attend to your health above all other matters. Your good health now means so much not only to you but to others and you should be careful.
