MARCATO.

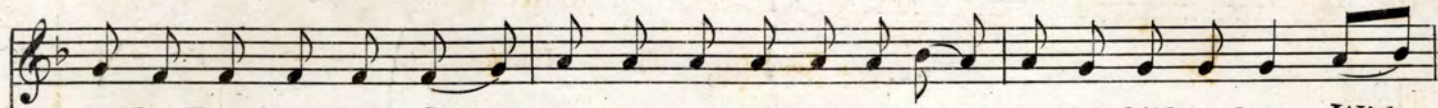
