Magee, Mississippi,

February 11th. 1913.

Dear Mama:-

I have your letter relating the sad news about the death of little Lamar Hollingsworth. I had letter from "Carle Ellis yesterday afternoon from Florence telling me about the awful affair and I saw in the paper yesterday afternoon an account of the terrible death of the little boy. I recall the boy well and remember that Sister and Cora spoke of his being such a lovable child; that he spent a great deal of his time with you all. I hate so much to hear of the death of so bright and sweet child. I have sold out business here and will wind up every thing now within about 30 to 60 days. I sold store building and goods last week. I shall have time I think to spend awhile with you all after a bit.

I do not know what I shall do. I guess that I will find employment of some kind. I do not care however if I do not find anything until another year. I may read and study for a year. I am trying to sell my home here and some other property of mine but cannot find a buyer. Times are so hard.

I will write again soon.
