5950. You are looking out W. N. W. from the beach. The bluffs known as Sutro Heights rise at your right, and the city stretches away over the steep hills and down again to the level of a land-locked bay at the east. The famous "Golden Gate" between the Bay and this broad Pacific opens farther up shore, beyond the point where you see the hotel. The distant heights standing up against the sky are away over beyond the north side of the Golden Gate.

Seals swim about in the waters off this shore, and their favorite place for sunning themselves after a frolic in the surf is on those rocks yonder. You see the great level stretches of sea beyond the Seal Rocks, at the left? They reach unbroken to the very horizon. If you were to sail straight in that direction you could move on and on and on, day after day, with no sight of any-

thing but sea and sky till you reached the lonely shores of Kamchatka. Or, if you sailed straight west from here (a bit to the left), the very first sight of land would be the coast of Japan. Tokio is in nearly the same latitude as San Francisco.
