## Receipt for Cotton to be Shipped, January 14, 1817

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P & H No 5 to 656.

Shipped by John Wickham in good order  
& well condition on board of sundry Flat Bottom  
boats wharf & master Capt James White now lying  
at Ditto Landing on the Demure River bound  
for New Orleans to say Four hundred eighty  
six bales of Cotton weighing One hundred thirty  
three thousand five hundred & twelve pounds  
being marked & numbered as in the margin.  
To be delivered in like good order & well  
condition at the aforesaid port of New Orleans  
(the danger of the River only excepted) unto Ben-  
jamin Stovall or his assigns he or they paying freight  
for the said Cotton at the rate of One Cent  
per pound. In witness whereof the master of  
said boats hath affixed to these bills of  
Lading all of this tenor & date the one  
of which bills being accomplished the other  
to stand void, dated at Ditto Landing  
14<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1817.
