Dear Sir

When I last saw you, you gave me a Mem^o. to make some enquiries for you in the Probate office - four cases -

I enclose you a statement containing such information as I could get -

We never see Trustey or Kingy here - And probably you see McCallister, Stephens, & Miller as often as we do -

OKO Talk to them all as you see them, and threaten them - tho it is probable that no legal means would be of avail against any of them unless it be Kingy or McCallister -

It is McCallister's duty to wind up Bradburys admⁿ of Stephens estate -
