


Legation of the United

a little tree yesterday
evening to put all
our presents on &
tomorrow we go to
a Christmas party
at Mrs. Chew's (our
secretary's wife) & Monday
to another American
Ladies. We have about
a weeks vacation
before us & are going
to have a very

pleasant time. Is Grandpa
still with you?

Brother & I have both had the
measles in a very light form
since I wrote last, which has
rather stopped our skating
for a short time, but we
are quite well now.
