Fredricksburg Va. June 8th 1866

Perry Clark Esq.

Sir:

The buildings and ground owned by you and known as the Stearns Gleaning Mills, have been occupied for Govt. purposes since May 25th 1865 and are so reported on my Report of Persons and articles hired, to the Dir. Genl. I have made no estimate of the amount of rent, but simply reported them as having been occupied but judging from the amount of rent allowed other buildings, should judge that \$20.00 per month would be a fair allowance of rent
