Dear Mote:-

I enclose you the rent note for 1913 duly cancelled

I have ordered sent you the Pump Stand from Memphis which I hope will reach you within a few days. I also spoke to Grantham about the well curbing. You see him and you can get what you need for that purpose. I gave him the bill for it.

I was talking with Stringer and he too wants to embark in the Sugar Cane business to some extent. I told him if he failed to find land around on his side of the place to go over the Rail Road where you were not working and where it would not interfere with the selection of land by you and see what he could find. I therefor think it best for you and Sim to select at once all your farm land for another year. You would do well to see about Seed Cane also. I understand that it requires about 2000 stalks to the acre to plant it well. You might go ahead preparing the 10 acres that you wish to plant to Cane in the way we talked about and I will draw contract and send over to you to see if it would

suit you. It would cost me a good deal of money and I would have to be sure of a good test and perfect cultivation and preparation before I would be willing to put out so much cash on it.

I forgot to pay Mr. Hester for the Hay Press but will send him check to-day. You may take the Press back to him at once.
