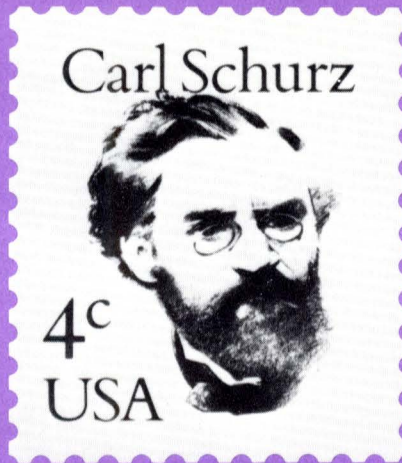

A four-cent regular postage stamp honoring Carl Schurz was issued in Watertown, Wisconsin, on June 3. Watertown was selected as the first day of issue city because Schurz settled there in 1854, the year that several thousand German immigrants arrived there. In addition, Schurz's wife founded
