

**Treatment of Behavior Problems in Dogs and Cats, Second edition**

By Henry Askew



This comprehensive guide to the diagnosis and treatment of dog and cat behavior problems details a new scientific approach which was first developed in the United States almost thirty years ago and is now being practiced by veterinarians and other pet behavior problem specialists in many countries throughout the world. The current scientific understanding of each behavioral problem is reviewed before specific advice is offered on differential diagnosis, possible causal factors and the most effective behavioral and pharmacological treatments available. Annotated diagrams are provided for each of the major behavior problems, summarizing key points, so that information can be obtained both quickly and easily when needed.

Mendeley is a citation manager that allows you to create your own personal database of references by importing records from research databases such as Scopus and others. Learn how to build a Mendeley library, share references with other researchers, and use the plug-in to cite as you write.

### **Searching Pubmed Effectively**

PubMed, a database produced by the National Library of Medicine, is a comprehensive and premier resource for searching in the scientific literature, particularly related to biomedical and life sciences. In this workshop, you will learn the essentials about PubMed and review how to conduct a more focused search using MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) terms.

### **Introduction to Zotero**

Zotero is a free cloud-based citation management system that captures journal articles, books, webpages, and newspaper articles, to seamlessly save them for citations and bibliographies. It comes with a MS Word plug-in to easily manage citations while writing.

### **Developing a Literature Review: An Overview for Graduate Students**

In this workshop, we'll cover the basics of how to structure and write a literature review, with a focus on the thesis or dissertation review.

### **Tracking Changes in Microsoft Word**

### **Publishing 101: Navigating the Academic Publishing Process**
