

PubMed, a database produced by the National Library of Medicine, is a comprehensive and premier resource for searching in the scientific literature, particularly related to biomedical and life sciences. In this workshop, you will learn the essentials about PubMed and review how to conduct a more focused search using MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) terms.

### **Getting the Most out of Scopus**

Scopus is a multidisciplinary database with strong coverage in sciences, engineering, and social sciences. This workshop will show advanced features of Scopus such as cited reference searching, setting up folders, creating search alerts, and maintaining a Scopus author page. Other search tips will be provided as well.

Are you new to online classes? Do you have assignments that require library resources but are unsure where to start? Help is here! Mendeley is a citation manager that allows you to create your own personal database of references by importing records from research databases such as Scopus and others. MSU students, faculty, and staff have access to the Mendeley Institutional Edition. Learn how to build a Mendeley library, share references with other researchers, and use the plug-in to cite as you write.

Plagiarism is a major problem in academic circles and goes far beyond simple "copy and paste." This workshop offers practical steps, from beginning your research to finalizing your citations and reference page, to keep your papers plagiarism-free!
