Dear Creek Mite
May 1874.

My Dearest Kattie:

It is with great pleasure that I take my pencil to answer your dear letter that came safely to hand last Wednesday morning. I have no more to write for times are as dull as a old case knife. Would have answered sooner but was waiting until after Sunday so I could tell you all about preaching.

We had the preacher and his wife with us

Saturday night. How are
you getting along
making boxes? If I was
there I would try my best
to make 1 thousand a day.
Mr. C. & W. wasn't at
preaching Sunday. Of
course he knew you
would not be there. Gee
I wish Lula and myself
could have been
there to enjoyed a good
chat about Sam Lennie.
Now Katie please dont
let Willie cut me out
down there you know who
I am talking about dont
you? How is Carl and
Mrs Roberts getting along?
Oh I forgot to tell
John L. was
at preaching.

He looked like a
bean pole dressed
up with tan shoes on.

Aunt Addie spent the
day with us yesterday.
She is going to your
house Friday.

Johnif was at
preaching. I thought of
Mollie the moment I
seen him. Lela Puckett
and her old man was
at preaching. They looked
right loving. Jim

Beaufort's turn out
went to Luther's for
dinner. I never hear
of Joe going to see
Florence now. I know
she hates that don't you?
Nattie I cant write a
long letter this time as it

will soon be time to start
dinner. Hope it will not
be long before I will see
you all. How does Ciza
and Jessie like to
make boxes? I declare I
can hardly write the
pleas nearly take me out
of my chair one will
kiss me every once and
a while. How is Mrs Green's
health now? I know you
are sorry if it is better.
Well I will close my letter
for this answer as soon
as you receive it. Excuse
bad writing. Give my love
to all. Kiss Cloise for me.
