I started this letter yesterday evening but did not get it finished. It is ~~very~~ colder tonight and has been raining some. I have a sore throat but think it may not get worse. I have taken all three of the cold shots.

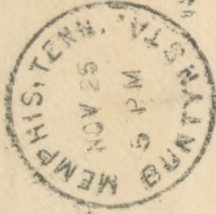
Harry said yesterday evening that Squire Kearney said he was having blue prints drawn up for the poultry houses and a cottage for Gale so they could start construction right away.
