On or before the 15th day of
October 1900, I promise to pay
to C. A. Williams, or order, two
thousand pounds (2000 lbs) of bent
Cotton ready baled for market,
for rent on land described as
follows: All the land marked
or cultivated by ~~him~~ ^{him} in cotton
during the year 1899, and 8 acres
in the north end of the land
cultivated by C. A. Williams in
corn during 1899, commencing at
a point near the crossing in the
branch and running with a ditch,
or dike, west to the Dabney
line - also for rent on
one bay baled mule named
"Boie"

Witness my hand this the 10th
day of November 1899.
