Port Gibson, March 11th 1840

Received of Jno. P. Darden three thou=  
-and dollars for and in consideration of  
four negro slaves, to wit, Martha aged  
about 14 years, Mary 17 years Smith  
15 years & Emily 14 years all of Dark  
complexion, which negroes I warrant  
to, sound in mind and body and  
slaves for life & free from the claim  
or claims of any & all persons whatsoever.
