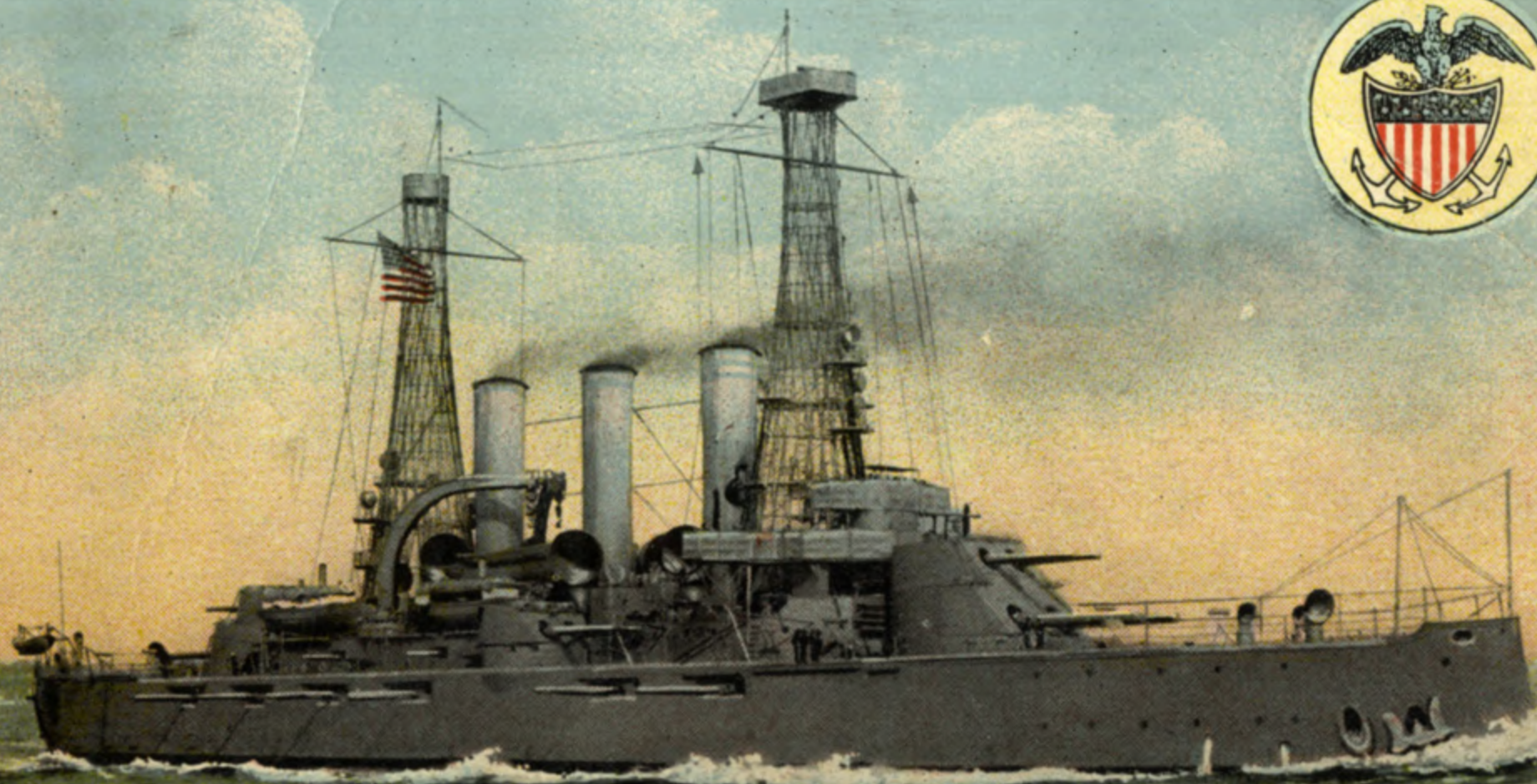

Displacement, about 17,000 tons; speed, 19 knots; 25,500 H. P. Length, 441 ft.; beam, 76 1-6 ft.; draught, 28 ft. Crew of 910 men. Carries four 12 in. guns, eight 8 in. guns and 28 smaller guns, with four 21 in. torpedo tubes. Armor belt, 11 ins. amidships; 12—8 ins. on turrets; 10—7 ins. on barbettes. Completed, May, 1907. Cost, \$6,500,000.
