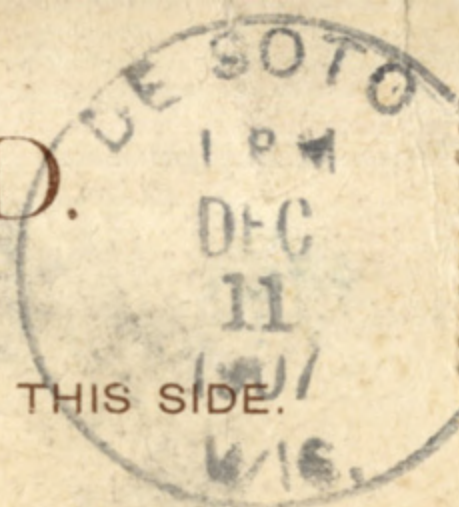

An armored cruiser, 502 feet long and 70 feet broad, with a displacement of 13,680 tons of water. It has a speed of over 22 knots per hour. Horse-power, 23,000. Cost, \$3,890,000. Armed with four 8-inch and fourteen 6-inch guns and a powerful secondary battery. Complement, 41 officers and 791 men.
