“ WASHINGTON, D. C., October 8th, 1862.

“ Major Gen. GRANT :

“ I congratulate you and all concerned in your recent battles and victories. How does it all sum up. I especially regret the death of Gen. Hackleman, and am very anxious to know the condition of Gen. Oglesby, who is an intimate personal friend.
