Thank you for your letter relative to school busing.

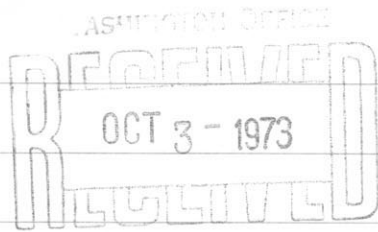
