Dear Sir

A letter from my son
H. C. Ball, says he is in the
hospital again threatened with
the measles. This was the 26th -
I have heard nothing from him
since, may I ask to be kept
fully informed as to his
condition, also your opinion
as to his work. His last month's
report was very low indeed, but
as I understand it he was
in hospital with strained ankle
and laid up with cold fully one
half the time, and was not at
examination, this is a serious
matter with me, as I am putting
forth every effort to keep him

with you, and shall still try
to do so, if it is best. He says
he is so much of the time
unable to eat and can not
sleep. He has been troubled with
Asthma until last winter he
had none and I had hoped
had out grown it. I hope you
will investigate this matter for
me at once. I am very sorry
to trouble you, but feel that it
must be done
