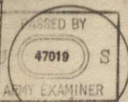

Got a couple of packages of dried figs and a new fountain pen from home. Dads okay, don't it, even if it is the dime store variety according to Dad. Also got a letter from Mom enclosing one of your letters and a V-mail from Julie. You must be getting to be quite a cook. Brush up on that lemon pie and I'll let you make me one when I get home. Do you know what outfit Roger is in? If you do you may be able to work I keep up with me. Not doing much right now - just getting fat and lazy. Looks a little like I may have been jilted again. Got a letter from another boy asking if I knew anything about Ann being engaged. I don't worry me much, though because I believe she would have told me. Thanks again Sir. Be good. All my love,

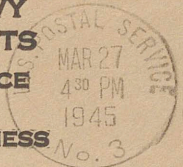
