His Excellency,

Gov. W. C. Cates,

Montgomery, Ala.

My dear Governor:

On the 30th. of July last I sent you by registered letter special warrant or certificate No. 6854. \$ 20.00, which I had procured from Gov. Jones, my letter explaining fully how it was obtained, and requesting that the treasurer return the twenty dollars which I deposited for the loan of the warrant, as Gov. Jones wrote me would be done. The receipt for the registered letter was promptly returned, signed by your private secretary, but I have heard nothing more about the matter. Supposing you have overlooked it, I write this to invite your attention to my request.
