It is the intention to inaugurate Gov. Lengine with military honors, and the Mississippi National Guard will participate. The President of Mississippi College has asked that his two Companies be allowed a place in the procession, which request has been most cordially granted, and I take pleasure in now extending an invitation to the Agricultural College Battalion, through you as President of that Institution, to be present and take part in the ceremonies. I have secured a rate from the several Railroads throughout the State for one cent per mile for each mile traveled where fifteen or more men in uniform travel on one ticket. Each organization must pay its own expenses. I shall be glad to hear from you.
