Dearest Mom & Dad,

We didn't get out of Leve as soon as we expected, but we are leaving at 6 o'clock in the morning, so I'll be in England sometime tomorrow night. Jack & I have just been loafing north. They have two movies here, and stage shows a couple of times a week so things aren't too dull. Yesterday we walked two or three miles along the cliffs overlooking the channel. It's beautiful, but there are still many German installations, obstacles, and mine fields scattered up and down the Beach. I don't remember whether or not I've re-assured you, but I think it will be quite safe to send 2 more packages. If you can find furnished gloves & some more heavy socks it'd be grand. Love,
