My Dear Sir and Brother:-

I inclose herewith Special Dispensation authorizing Tylertown Lodge, No. 592 to celebrate the 21st. of June, 1908, instead of the 24th., St. John's Day. I was not quite clear in my mind as to the power of the Grand Master on this point, and waited to confer with the committee, or rather chairman of the Committee on Law and Jurisprudence. It gives me pleasure to comply with your request, but unless the Lodge has already done so- which does not appear from your letter, you will have the Lodge vote on the question of suspending Section 5, of the By-laws, when, if a majority vote affirmatively, your authority is complete.
