TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME:

KNOW YE, That I, John M. Stobe, Grand Master of Masons to and for the State of Mississippi, by virtue of the power and authority to me vested, do hereby grant this, my Special Dispensation to Meridian Lodge No. 506, to vote on the petition of Mr. E. M. Martin at a special meeting of said Meridian Lodge No. 506, F. A. M., at Meridian, Mississippi, to be called by the Master of said Lodge on any day prior to the 10th day of May, 1900, and to confer all the degrees at the same time upon the said E. M. Martin, provided he shall be accepted.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto placed my signature, and affixed the Seal of the Grand Lodge of Mississippi, on the day and date above written.
