Dear Brother Gellier:-

I have just returned from Grenada where I went at the invitation of the District Deputies, and Grand Lecturer, and now comply with your request to put in writing the Dispensation to confer out of time, the Masters degree on Brother Lees, Fellow Craft. I received your letter before I left home, but did not have time to attend to it until after my return.

I also find on my return your favor repeating the request, and returning to me the Dispensation granted to confer the Master's degree on your son, and which you did not use.
