ULYSSES SIMPSON GRANT

Born at Point Pleasant, Ohio, Apr. 27, 1822; died July 23, 1885. American soldier and twice President of the United States. After a series of brilliant victories, including Fort Donelson and Vicksburg, was appointed general in chief of the Union armies in 1864. Hard hitting and determined, performed best under adverse conditions.
