WILLIAM TECUMSEH SHERMAN

Born at Lancaster, Ohio, Feb. 8, 1820; died in New York, Feb. 14, 1891. American soldier who served in the Mexican and Civil Wars. Distinguished in many campaigns, but particularly noted as the leader of the "march through Georgia" and to the sea. He succeeded Grant as general and as commander of United States army in 1869.
