GEORGE ARMSTRONG CUSTER

Born at New Rumley, Ohio, Dec. 5, 1839; died in Montana, June 25, 1876. An American soldier and Indian fighter, remembered for "Custer's Last Stand." A distinguished cavalry officer in the Civil War, he served under Sheridan in the Shenandoah Valley campaign and was brevetted a major general of volunteers in 1865.
