Keynote Speakers

Elyse Hill

Ms. Hill is a professional certified genealogist with over 15 years of research experience in African American genealogy. She is a graduate of several genealogy institutes to include the Institute of Genealogy & Historical Research (IGHR), Genealogical Research Institute of Pittsburgh (GRIP), and the Midwest African American Genealogy Institute (MAAGI). She is currently working as a professional genealogy researcher for Legacy Tree Genealogists specializing in Africa American and Southern States research.

France O. Robb

Frances Osborn Robb, a historian of southern photography, is the author of Shot in Alabama. A History of Photography 1839-1941 (University of Alabama Press, 2017), and is writing a book about A. C. Oxford, who grew up in Mississippi, fought in the Civil War with General Joseph Wheeler, and became Birmingham's first resident photographer in the 1870s. Robb holds graduate degrees from the University of North Carolina and Yale University and has made scores of presentations to academics and the general public.

DeeDee Baldwin is the history librarian and liaison to the Honors College at Mississippi State. Her research interests include paleography, women's work, vintage recipes and historic foodways, the complexities of legal records of enslaved persons, and pirates.
